Audio-Visual Requirements

Slides: Dr. Labib's PowerPoint slides will be sent 48 hours in advance and must be pre-loaded and tested before his arrival.

A/V Check: Dr. Labib arrives 30-45 minutes early for a private

A/V check. If unavailable, an alternative time must be arranged.

Microphone: A wireless lavalier microphone is required for groups over 25. A confidence monitor and countdown clock are strongly preferred.

Stage Setup: Ensure a clear front stage, as Dr. Labib moves while presenting. Furniture should be at least 6 feet from the stage or removed.

Screen Placement: Use a single screen placed off to the side or above the stage to keep Dr. Labib as the focal point.

Scheduling & Logistics

Pre-Session Setup: Schedule a break before his presentation for A/V setup and testing.

Post-Session Break: Schedule a break after his talk to allow audience interaction and discussion.

Travel: Dr. Labib prefers arriving the night before. Book a non-smoking hotel near the venue or airport, with a high floor and late checkout.

Slides & Content

Slide Format: Dr. Labib uses his custom-designed slides, not event templates, to supplement his speech.

Materials: The full slide deck is not for download or distribution. An outline for educational purposes can be provided on the session day.

Rights: All materials are Dr. Labib's intellectual property and cannot be reproduced or distributed.

Recordings & Photography

Photography: Flash photography is allowed before the talk but not during. Recording requires prior agreement and testing to ensure quality. Dr. Labib retains all rights to session materials.
